

FOREIGN LANGUAGES (GERM1-CE)

GERM1-CE 9001 German I (0 Credits)

If you have never studied German, take this introductory course to acquire the basic pronunciation, vocabulary, useful expressions, and fundamental grammatical notions that allow for effective communication. Classes are conducted in German.

Grading: SPS Non-Credit Graded

Repeatable for additional credit: Yes

GERM1-CE 9002 German II (0 Credits)

In this course that builds upon German I, continue to expand your vocabulary and to master more grammatical structures. The instructor provides greater opportunities for expanding the range of your conversational ability. Classes are conducted in German.

Grading: SPS Non-Credit Graded

GERM1-CE 9003 German III (0 Credits)

Expand your knowledge of the essential vocabulary, verb forms, case systems, and basic tenses of German. Focus on expanding your vocabulary, learning more complex grammatical structures, and having simple conversations. Classes are conducted in German.

Grading: SPS Non-Credit Graded

Repeatable for additional credit: Yes

GERM1-CE 9004 German IV (0 Credits)

If you have a solid knowledge of the essential vocabulary, verb forms, case system, and basic tenses of German, or if you have completed German III, then this course is the next step in your study of German. Focus on expanding your vocabulary, learning more complex grammatical structures, and having simple conversations. Classes are conducted in German.

GERM1-CE 9005 German V (0 Credits)

Expand your vocabulary and enrich your grammatical means of expression in German. Build your reading, writing, and conversational skills through reading assignments and watching video and web-based material, which are then used as a basis for discussion and writing. Topics include sports and health, the business environment, and business concepts. Grammatical structures include subjunctives, "wenn" clauses, indirect questions, questions with and without interrogative pronouns, and the passive voice. This course is appropriate for students at the advanced level.

GERM1-CE 9015 German: Accelerated I and II (0 Credits)

If you have previously studied German and want to review the basics, or if you have a strong knowledge of a cognate language, then this course is for you. This fast-paced course condenses the material covered in two levels into the time it normally takes to complete one. Homework assignments are an important part of the curriculum. Classes are conducted in German.

Grading: SPS Non-Credit Graded

GERM1-CE 9016 German: Accelerated III and IV (0 Credits)

If you have a solid knowledge of German-language basics (essential vocabulary, verb forms, the case system, and basic tenses), or if you have completed Level II and want to increase your expertise at an accelerated rate, then this course is for you. This fast-paced course condenses the material covered in two levels into the time it normally takes to complete one. Focus on expanding your vocabulary, learning more complex grammatical structures, and holding simple conversations.

Grading: SPS Non-Credit Graded

Repeatable for additional credit: Yes

GERM1-CE 9018 German V (0 Credits)

In this course, students continue to expand their vocabulary and enrich their grammatical means of expression in German. Build your reading, writing, and conversational skills through reading assignments and watching video and web-based material, which are then used as a basis for discussion and writing. Topics include sports and health, the business environment, and business concepts. Grammatical structures include subjunctives, "wenn" clauses, indirect questions, questions with and without interrogative pronouns, and the passive voice. This course is appropriate for students at the advanced level.
