

MUSIC INSTRUMENTAL: BRASS (MPABR-GE)

MPABR-GE 2111 Brass Instrmnt (Private Lessons) (2-3 Credits)

Typically offered Fall and Spring

Open to departmental graduate students majoring in music. Private lessons in brass instruments. All styles & forms supplemented by extra assignments. Jury examination required at end of semester. Required attendance at brass recitals & master classes.

MPABR-GE 2121 Brass Choir (0-3 Credits)

Typically offered Fall and Spring

Rehearsal techniques and special problems in ensemble performance.

MPABR-GE 2124 Brass Pedagogy (1 Credit)

Typically offered Spring

This course provides students with foundational knowledge of pedagogical approaches for teaching brass instruments through established methods and repertoire. Students gain knowledge of pedagogical approaches and resources for teaching brass at various levels, put new information into practice through teaching demonstrations and research assignments, and explore methods on organizing and managing a private studio.

MPABR-GE 2131 Chamber Ensemble (0-3 Credits)

Typically offered Spring

Rehearsal techniques and special problems in ensemble performance.

MPABR-GE 2136 Brass Performance Juries (0 Credits)

Instrumental Performance juries assess each student's growth in instrumental techniques including intonation, rhythm, tone production, articulation, dynamics, and musicality. Juries take place at a designated time at the end of the semester and are evaluated by each student's program director and any additional invited faculty. Jury repertoire is selected in conversation with each student's private teacher, and each student studies their jury repertoire in their private lessons.

MPABR-GE 2141 Brass and Piano Repertoire (0-3 Credits)

Typically offered Fall and Spring

MPABR-GE 2181 Graduate Recital in Brass (1-2 Credits)

This course is a culmination of a student's graduate degree. It requires the student to incorporate elements from their entire course of study to research, program, prepare, and present a successful degree recital.

MPABR-GE 2300 Independent Study (1-6 Credits)
