PROF1-CE 1010 Afrikaans 12-Point Proficiency Exam (0 Credits)

Demonstrate listening comprehension skills, translate one 150-word passage into English and one into the test language, and write a brief essay. Knowledge of technical or specialized vocabulary is not needed; dictionaries and the like are not permitted. The test may be taken on-site at NYU or off-site; students have two hours to complete it. Point scoring is equivalent to undergraduate credits at U.S. colleges; credit granted is at the discretion of the institution receiving the results. Students are strongly urged to discuss accreditation with the institution's advisor prior to the exam.
