The History of Public Health at NYU

In the years since the NYU Board of Trustees established the School of Global Public Health, we've expanded our programs, successfully earned accreditation, and graduated over 3,000 public health professionals at the Master's and Doctoral level. With innovation in public health urgently needed around the world, the creation of our school could not have been more timely. The story of the study of public health at New York University began over 90 years ago when, in 1931, health courses were first offered in the School of Education. Course by course, degree by degree, the public health program gathered multi-disciplinary strength as it evolved across colleges from one end of our campus to the other.
