

REGISTRATION

NYU Grossman Long Island School of Medicine's Office of Registration and Student Records (<https://medli.nyu.edu/education/md-degree/registration-student-records/>) supports students with the practical aspects of their medical education. The office assists with registration, manages academic records, maintains course catalogs, and helps with class schedules.

The office also provides information about the academic calendars (<https://medli.nyu.edu/education/md-degree/registration-student-records/md-student-academic-calendars/>); elective, clerkship, and advanced clinical rotation lotteries (<https://medli.nyu.edu/education/md-degree/registration-student-records/lotteries/>); away rotations; the licensure exam; residency applications; and the resident matching process. On request, the office provides services such as official copies of transcripts and diplomas.
