

TUITION AND FINANCIAL AID

Tuition

Withdrawal and Refund of Tuition

A student who, for any reason, finds it impossible to complete one or more courses must first consult with a College of Arts and Science academic adviser.

The University has specific procedures, policies, and deadlines governing course withdrawals (whether full or partial). Exceptions to the University Registrar's published refund schedule may be appealed by submitting a petition to the Refund Committee in the College Advising Center (726 Broadway, 7th Floor; 212-998-8130). Petitions must be submitted with supporting documentation that outline the circumstances that warrant consideration of an exception.
