## Tuition

## Withdrawal and Refund of Tuition

A student who, for any reason, finds it impossible to complete one or more courses for which he or she has registered must first consult with a College of Arts and Science academic adviser.

The University has specific procedures, policies, and deadlines governing course withdrawals (whether full or partial). Please go to [www.nyu.edu/bursar](http://www.nyu.edu/bursar) (<http://www.nyu.edu/bursar/>), then select "Refunds," then select "Dropping Classes/Semester Withdrawals."

Exceptions to the University Registrar's published refund schedule may be appealed by submitting a petition to the Refund Committee in the College Advising Center (726 Broadway, 7th Floor; 212-998-8130). Petitions must be submitted with supporting documentation that outline the circumstances that warrant consideration of an exception.
