

CREATIVE WRITING IN SPANISH (MINOR)

Program Description

The minor in Creative Writing in Spanish encourages emerging writers to discover their strengths and develop skills in creative writing across genres (fiction, poetry, prose) and in a range of other expressive techniques. This four-course (16-credit) minor is comprised of three practical workshops in creative writing and one advanced course in literature of the student's choosing (a "300-level course"). Through this training, students improve their communication and comprehension skills in Spanish—skills which are transferable to a range of professional fields, such as journalism and commercial writing. The program's faculty includes prominent Latin American, Spanish, and Latinx writers who teach courses in the minor and offer individual guidance to students.

The Department of Spanish and Portuguese is an interdisciplinary department focused on the languages, cultural formations, and critical thought emerging from Latin America, the Caribbean, Spain, and the Luso-Afro-Brazilian world. Minor Declaration

Program Policies

Department of Spanish and Portuguese: Policies Applying to All Minors

Students who wish to minor must declare with the department and select courses in consultation with the director of undergraduate studies. All minor courses must be completed with a grade of C or better (Pass/Fail grades do not count). Transfer students must complete at least half the courses for their minor (three courses for a five-course minor) in residence at NYU.

Double Counting of Courses

Minors may share (double count) one course with a major or a second minor, with permission from the other department/program.
