Program Description

The interdisciplinary program merges the longstanding excellence in nursing education at NYU with an in-depth perspective on public health approaches. Students will study a variety of topics and will also work closely with an adviser to select the right mix of electives to complement individual interests and career paths. Students who complete the Global Public Health/Nursing degree will complete all the same nursing major courses and clinical hours as in the existing state-approved nursing major at NYU.
