Dual Degree

The College of Nursing offers a dual BS/MS (<https://nursing.nyu.edu/academics/masters/bsms/?tgid=nyunursing-tabs-4151&tid=overview>) degree which enables students to obtain a bachelor's degree in nursing and advance to a master's degree that prepares them to be advanced practice nurses serving in roles such as nurse practitioners, nurse-midwives, or informaticists.
